ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: During the assembly procedure, nuts and bolts should be hand tightened. Once the assembly is complete, nuts and bolts must be fully tightened.

- 1. Attach two 3-1/2" Swivel Casters (9) to Base Frame (1) using Bolts (21), Nuts (30) and Lock Washers (31).
- Attach two 3" Swivel Casters (10) to Base Frame (1) using Bolts (22) and Lock Washers (31)
- 3. Attach one 3-1/2" Swivel Casters (9) to each Leg (4) using Bolts (21), Nuts (30) and Lock Washers (31).
- Insert the Legs (4) into the Base Frame (1) and lock the Legs in place using four Locking Pins (5). Secure these in place using four Hairpin Cotter Clips (7).

- 5. Attach the Main Post (3) to the Base Frame (1) using Bolts (19), Nuts (25), and Flat Washers (26).
- 6. Secure the Boom (2) to the Main Post (3) using a Bolt (15), Nut (23) and Flat Washer (24).
- 7. Attach the support straps (6) to the top of the Main Post using Bolts (16), Nuts (23) and Flat Washers (24).
- 8. Attach the support straps (6) to the Base Frame (1) using Bolts (14), Nuts (23) and Flat Washers (24).
- 9. Connect bottom of Ram (11) to Main Post (3) using Bolt (17), Nut (23) and Flat Washer (24).
- Have an assistant hold the Boom (2) up. Attach the top of the Ram (11) using a Bolt (18), Nut (23) and Flat Washer (24).
- 11. Slide the Boom Extension (13) into the Boom (2) and secure in one of the four positions using a Bolt (19), Nut (25) and Flat Washer (26).
- 12. Tighten all Nuts and Bolts.

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE FIRST USE

- To familiarize yourself with basic operation, turn the release valve lever:
 - a. Clockwise until firm resistance is felt to further turning. This is the 'CLOSED' release valve position used to raise the ram plunger.
 - b. Counter-clockwise, but no more than 2 turns from the closed position. This is the 'OPEN' release valve position used to lower the ram plunger.

AWARNING: Clear all tools and personnel before lowering load. Open release valve slowly. The further the handle is turned counter-clockwise, the faster the load will descend. Maintain control of the load at all times.

- With ram plunger fully retracted, remove the oil filler plug. Insert the handle into the handle sleeve, and then pump 6 to 8 strokes. This will help release any pressurized air, which may be trapped within the reservoir. Ensure the oil level is just below the oil filler hole. Reinstall the oil filler plug.
- Check to ensure that the crane rolls freely and that the pump and release valve operate smoothly. Raise and lower the unloaded crane throughout the lifting range before putting into service.

OPERATION WARNINGS

AWARNING: Use of this engine crane is limited to lifting, lowering, and transporting in the lowest possible position, automotive and light truck engines. It is NOT and should never be used as a work station.

AWARNING: Always refer to vehicle service manual and/or shop manual for location of appropriate engine lift points and removal procedures.

AWARNING: Lift only on areas of the engine as specified by the vehicle manufacturer.

AWARNING: Never load the crane with an engine that extends beyond an imaginary line drawn connecting the centerlines of the front and rear wheel/caster axles!

 Ensure that the load does not exceed the rated capacity of your chosen boom and leg position.





- 2. Secure appropriately rated engine leveler, chain or sling assembly (sold separately) to the vehicle manufacturers' recommended engine lift points.
- 3. Secure the engine crane safety hook assembly to the engine leveler, chain or sling assembly.
- 4. Refer to vehicle service manual and/or shop manual for location of appropriate engine lift points and removal procedures. Each engine removal/installation may require different tools, procedures, and level of expertise.
- 5. When ready to remove engine, turn release valve clockwise until firm. Pump handle until load is high enough to clear vehicle. Before moving, ensure the load is:
 - a. At the lowest practical position and always below the center of gravity.
 - b. Prevented from swinging and inadvertent shifting.

AWARNING: Never put any portion of your body under a load supported by the engine crane. Keep crane on hard, smooth, level surface. Before moving crane, lower the boom as far below horizontal as possible, yet still allowing movement!

- 6. Remove engine, then immediately transfer the engine to appropriate engine support device (engine stand). Turn release valve lever counter-clockwise to lower the load, but never more than 2 full turns. Control the rate of descent of the load at all times. The more you open the release valve, the faster the load descends.
- 7. Ensure stand is secure before working on or around.

STORAGE:

Always store the Engine Crane in a well-protected area where it will not be exposed to inclement weather, corrosive vapors, abrasive dust, or any other harmful elements.

- 1. Remove forward most Hairpin Cotter Clips (7) and Locking Pins (5).
- 2. Raise each leg until it nears vertical; reinstall Hairpin Cotter Clip (7) and Locking Pin (5).

MAINTENANCE

A periodic coating of light lubricating oil to pivot points, adjusting points, etc. will help to prevent rust and ensure that all components move freely.

DISPOSAL

At the end of the useful life of the 2 Ton Folding Shop Crane, dispose of the components according to all state, federal, and local regulations.


